Contemporary dance meets performance art – a post-dance – with Bianca Paige Smith and Eimear Byrne as 'Two Can Do'.


'Two Can Do'
A Duet. Two people. Two heads. Two blindfolds. Moving Art.
Common task?
Move together by listening to each other.
Common goal?
Show up fully and really listen.
Common experience?
Not really.
But we know what it is, when it's here. And so do you.
For who?
All of us. Including you.

What if you had support whenever you moved? What can we make when we know everything we do will be supported? If we were told we could do anything because we had the means, what would we try to do?

In this piece, two dancers work to support – physically – each other's movement ventures to create a dynamic, rhythmical and physical duet. The work uses principles of contemporary dance to explore the idea of support, trust and vulnerability in the arts. The question is... how much further can you go with a bit of support?



MEET THE ARTISTS




Bianca Paige Smith - Creator and Performer

Bianca Paige Smith (BS Neuroscience, MA Contemporary Dance Performance) born in NJ, is a multi-disciplinary artist, a visionary and creator currently creating work that draws from principles of post-modern Contemporary dance along with her experience with meditation and background in neuroscience. She earned her Masters in Contemporary Dance Performance at the University of Limerick and proceeded to perform throughout Ireland, the UK, inclusive of the prestigious Step Up Dance Project in 2017 with the award-winning UK Choreographer Gary Clarke.



Eimear Byrne – Performer

Eimear Byrne – (BA hons Dance, MA Contemporary Dance Performance) is a dance artist from Ireland and works professionally as a dancer, teacher at BIFE and choreographer working for the past 10 years in the dance industry. She was chosen to dance the female role in the repertoire of 'Coupled Reflections' by Robert Connor and Loretta Yurick in 2016/17 as a part of the 'Live Archive Project' curated by Emma Meehan. Eimear has also choreographed her own work, 'Renewal' which was performed in Ireland and the UK.



Shane Vaughan – Videographer

Shane Vaughan is a visual artist and media maker working in poetry, prose, photographer, videography and analogue film. His writing has been published in Silhouette Press, Poetry NI, The Pickled Body, Unbroken Journal, Honest Ulsterman, Silver Apples and elsewhere. His plays have performed in the Cork School of Music, and his photography has been exhibited in the Limerick College of Further Education as well as K-Fest, 2019. He co-runs Stanzas: an Evening of Words, where he publishes a chapbook of new writing every month and is a board member of The Limerick Fringe which debuted March 2017.
